Instructions travelling to Trieste:

Citizens and residents of **EU countries**, the **Schengen area**, from **Israel**, **Andorra** or the **Principality of Monaco** can enter Italy without the obligation of guarantine, provided that:

- 1. They fill in the Passenger Locator Form before entering Italy
- 2. They present the <u>EU Digital COVID Certificate</u> on arrival. Non-EU citizens can present a COVID-19 Green Certificate, in paper or digital form, issued by the health authorities of their home country, certifying negativity to the virus, successful recovery or vaccination recognized by the European Medicines Agency (EMA).
 - An EU Digital COVID Certificate is digital proof that a person:
 - has been vaccinated against COVID-19 at least 14 days beforehand
 - obtained a negative test result
 - recovered from COVID-19

The digital version can be saved on a mobile device. Citizens can also request a printed version. Both versions will have a QR code containing essential information and a digital signature ensuring their authenticity.

The EU Digital COVID Certificate is valid in all EU countries and the Schengen area.
